

# **City Projects**

## **South Van Buren Reconstruction Project**

The project is a \$5 million reconstruction of South Van Buren Road corridor from Snyder Avenue to Eastern Road.

### **Project Details:**


- New signal and update pedestrian facilities at S. Van Buren Ave. and Robinson Ave.
  - Pavement rehabilitation from Snyder Ave. to Harold Ave.
  - Full depth reconstruction from Harold Ave. to Russell Ave.
    - \*New pavement, curbs, sidewalks, drive aprons
      - \* Will need Work Agreements to properly construct some driveways on private property.
    - New water line from Snyder Avenue to Russell Avenue
      - \* Requires temporary water line to be placed on the ground during construction.
  - New storm sewer, outletting into culvert near Eastern Road
  - Pavement rehabilitation from Russell Avenue to Eastern Road.
    - Underground conduit for future fiber installation
- Temporary work agreements will be required on some properties for driveway work.

#### Maintenance of Traffic Scheme:

• Roadway Improvements: South Van Buren will be closed to through traffic throughout the duration of the construction project. Access to resident's homes will be maintained at all times. When a drive closure is necessary, the contractor is to notify the affected resident/s at



least 24 hours prior to the closure.



# Wooster Rd. W. Project

Wooster Road W will be reconstructed from 4th Street to Hudson Run and resurfaced from Hudson Run to 31st Street. Aspects of this project include:

- New sidewalks, curbs, gutters, and storm sewers
  - Replaced water valves

• Wooster Road W will undergo a Road Diet. A Road Diet typically involves converting an existing fourlane undivided roadway to a three-lane roadway consisting of two through lanes and a center two-way left-turn lane (TWLTL)

# **Barberton Fire Department**

#### Call 911 For Emergencies Only

911 should be called for incidents where it is vital that units respond immediately including: Fires, Medical Problems, Car Wrecks, and Law Enforcement incidents that are in progress, that have just occurred, or where a suspect is in the area. In order to answer the numerous Emergency calls as quickly as possible with the limited number of 911 phone lines and 911 Call-Takers in any community, calling 911 for any reason other than reporting an Emergency is prohibited.

#### How to use 911

9-1-1 is a universal number that is used when emergency services are needed i.e. the Police/ Fire Departments and Emergency Medical Services). It should only be used for the purpose of an emergency in these situations:

• When there is an imminent (about to occur or in the process of occurring) threat to the life of oneself, someone else or to property—including Hazmat emergencies.

 Threat To Life-In danger of serious bodily injury or death; also reporting of missing/kidnapped persons.
 Threat to Property/ Structure-When physical property (homes, buildings, bridges, aircraft, automobiles, trains, watercraft, and roads) is in danger of having its appearance and/or foundation altered in any manner by fire/explosion, collision, serious water damage, and natural disasters; especially if these pose a threat to life.
 Hazmat Emergencies-

Hazardous materials which include, but not limited to, certain gases, liquids, radio-active and infectious

materials that can be potentially flammable, explosive, corrosive, toxic, and poisonous which can cause serious illness, injury and/or death. (If you do not recognize a particular smell, liquid or substance, do not touch or approach it, call 9-1-1 and describe it and/or your symptoms to the call taker).



#### 9-1-1 is not to be used for:

- General information questions
- Obtaining phone numbers to other agencies and/or businesses
- Non-emergency complaints (refer to first page for definition of emergency)
- The purpose of reporting problems with non-emergency utility outages (i.e. lights out due to a storm, heat/air conditioning not working, water has been turned off, etc...)
- Because you didn't feel like looking up the non-emergency number to your local agency

#### Answer the Questions Being Asked

- Do not become irritated with the 9-1-1 operator when being asked questions concerning the nature of the call.
- These questions are to obtain information to, again, determine the place of the emergency, what is going on, and what type of service is needed.
- Most importantly the questions asked are for personnel safety as well.
